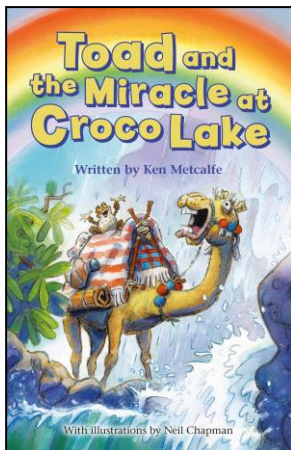

Nonetheless, 'Toad' was a story that continued to develop in my head, so with more time available now, I decided to write it down. I didn't stop writing for three months!"*
