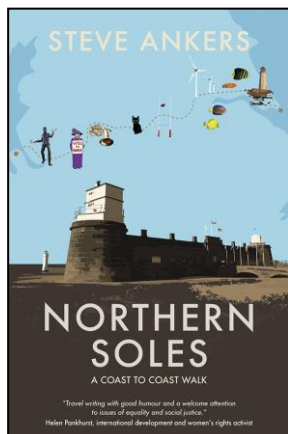

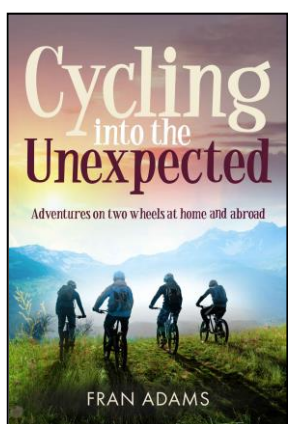
A COAST TO COAST WALK

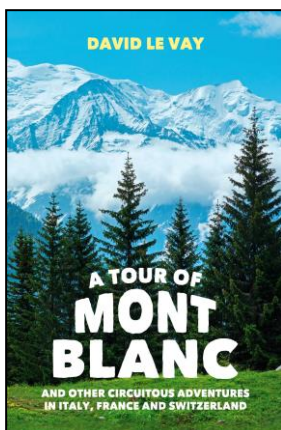
ADVENTURES ON TWO WHEELS AT HOME AND ABROAD

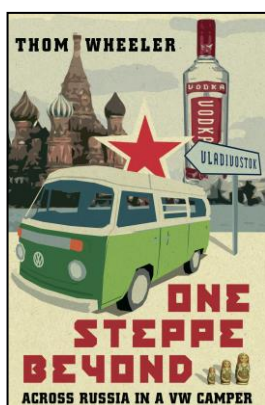
THE HAIRY HIKERS

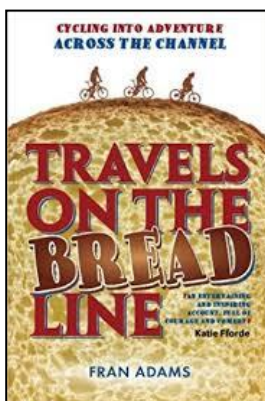
